UNAUDITED OPERATING STATISTICS FOR THE THREE MONTHS ENDED 31 MARCH 2021

The board of directors (the “Board”) of Road King Infrastructure Limited (the “Company”) announces that the sales of the Group (including the Company together with its subsidiaries, joint venture and associate companies) for the three months ended 31 March 2021 was about RMB15,268 million comprising property sales of RMB14,383 million and toll revenue of expressway projects of RMB885 million.

The property sales for the three months ended 31 March 2021 comprised contracted sales of RMB9,860 million, representing an increase of about 55% as compared with RMB6,377 million for the same period of last year and outstanding subscribed sales of RMB4,523 million. The average daily traffic volume of the expressway projects was 293,000 vehicles.
